### **Neighborhood Bank Makes Unique Historical Society Donation**

In the midst of building, moving and remodeling, Wauwatosa Savings Bank recovered 36 enlarged photographs from storage in its 75<sup>th</sup> and State Street location. It is believed that many are original pictures of homes, businesses and other sites in Wauwatosa dating back to the early 1900's.
