The office will offer on-site mortgage lending services and deposit products including a full range of checking accounts, money market and savings accounts, individual retirement accounts (IRAs), certificates of deposit, and the Moola Moola Kids' Savings account. Established in 1921, Wauwatosa Savings Bank is a financial institution celebrating its 85th year.
