**Brick Breaking Ceremony  
For the new West Allis branch office of  
Wauwatosa Savings Bank  
Held on Thursday, July 13, 2006**

Government officials, business neighbors, and contractors joined the people of Wauwatosa Savings Bank to mark the official brick breaking for the bank's construction of a new branch office at 10101 W. Greenfield Ave., West Allis, WI. The brick breaking ceremony precedes the demolition of a garage attached to the existing building to make way for the drive-up banking facility.

Wauwatosa Savings purchased the 27,500-square-foot building in June for the purpose of building a branch office in the single story portion and moving the bank's residential lending department to the second floor of the two-story portion. The new branch office is scheduled to be completed by March 2007 and the residential lending department is scheduled to move into the second floor offices by October 2006.

The new branch will feature three lanes of drive-up banking service including one with 24-hour ATM service. The office will offer on-site mortgage lending services and deposit products including a full range of checking accounts, money market and savings accounts, individual retirement accounts (IRAs), certificates of deposit, and the Moola Moola Kids' Savings account. Lobby hours will be 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday; 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Friday; 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Saturday. Drive-up banking hours will be 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday; 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Saturday.

Established in 1921, Wauwatosa Savings Bank is a financial institution celebrating its 85<sup>th</sup> year. The bank has \$1.5 billion in assets with offices in Wauwatosa, Oak Creek, Oconomowoc, Pewaukee, and Waukesha. In addition to the projected opening of the West Allis branch in March, new branch offices are scheduled to open in Franklin (August 2006) and Germantown (November 2006).
